## **LOCATION**

The Museum of Farnham is located at the Alton end of West Street in the centre of the town.

The nearest car park is in the Lower Hart (next to Waitrose) although the Upper Hart Car Park is cheaper. There is two hour parking outside the Museum, although availability is sometimes limited.
