In the course of work on the break-up of the Ashtead Park Estate, following the death of Mrs Howard, a complex picture has emerged, which is summarised below, together with notes on the chief sources which have been consulted to date.

Most references to local newspapers are to microfilm copies at Surrey Local Studies Library, Guildford.

*Surrey Advertiser* of 13 March 1878, refers to the sale of live farm stock, following the death of Mrs Howard.

**Surrey Record Office** holds copies of Sale Catalogues for 1879 and for 1924.

\* From the evidence to hand so far, it would seem that the 1878 sale never took place. There are various announcements of the forthcoming sale in the *Surrey Advertiser* and in the *West Middlesex Herald* during July 1878 - then silence! There is a very full advert in the *Surrey Advertiser* for 15 July.

The sale in 1878 was to have been of just over 332 acres. Apart from the Manorial Rights, the 1924 sale covered over 800 acres, as compared with over 4,000 acres, offered in 1879.

There was a full report of the 1879 sale in the *Sussex Agricultural Express*, *Weald of Kent Mail and County Advertiser* on 1 July. There was a brief note in the issue for 24 June - there may be confusion here as both reports have been attributed to the *Surrey Standard*.

There was a full report of the 1924 sale in the *Dorking and Leatherhead Advertiser*, *Epsom District Times and County Post* on 11 October.

I have prepared tables to show:

- a) Lot number and description, 1879 catalogue area, and newspaper area with additional notes



b) Details of farms included in the sale with details from the 1879 sale catalogue, plus Census information for 1871-91 inclusive

c) Details of the 1924 sale with lot and description, area, price realised, and some additional notes.

## GUILDFORD BOUNDARIES

**Note by R W Williams, 18th November 1988**

The Witherby map, published 1839, states in its heading that the borough boundaries shown resulted from the Act of Parliament 3 + 4 William 4, c.64.

In fact, I have checked both General and Local Acts at the British Library and find that Witherby made a mistake in the year, although he was so close to it. The Act concerned is part of

2 + 3 William 4, cap. 64 (1832)

which redefines boundaries in England and Wales, certain counties, cities and boroughs, as a result of the Reform Act. The Guildford entry is in Schedule O of the Act and the description of the new boundary is identical with that appearing at the foot of Witherby's map.

Further evidence is that the Parliamentary Borough Boundary is always referred to as the 1832 boundary.

3 + 4 William 4 would have been 1833/34.

I suggest you keep a Note with your copy of Witherby, pointing out the error, in case future researchers wish to see the original Act.

Witherby refers to 'The 1822 enlargement' in the bottom left hand corner of his map. He must have meant 1832, as there is no record of any boundary extension in 1822. He clearly was not very careful with his annotations, although the map is beautifully drawn.

### Also

The North point on the map is wrong. Compare it with the modern map. I haven't measured it but it is probably about 15° out!!
